A WATER-MINING CoP consists of a **group of diverse experts** who share an interest or
concern on water issues. By interacting regularly,
this group **exchanges knowledge**, **develops ideas and learns together**, thereby contributing

By joining a WATER-MINING CoP, you will connect to a network of stakeholders groups including end-users, technology providers, utilities, industries in the agriculture, energy and water sectors, regulators, local and regional authorities, and researchers. You will have the opportunity to build synergies and new professional relationships, and exchange knowledge with this diverse group. Furthermore, being involved in an EU project CoP can improve your professional visibility in an international context.

In the WATER-MINING CoPs, you will have the chance to **share** your knowledge and **ideas**, and **discuss** on the water issues and solutions addressed by the CoP during regular meetings.
