What is a CoP?

A WATER-MINING CoP consists of a **group of diverse experts** who share an interest or concern on water issues. By interacting regularly, this group **exchanges knowledge, develops ideas and learns together**, thereby contributing to innovative **solutions for sustainable water management**.

By joining a WATER-MINING CoP, you will **connect to a network** of stakeholders groups including end-users, technology providers, utilities, industries in the agriculture, energy and water sectors, regulators, local and regional authorities, and researchers. You will have the opportunity to **build synergies** and **new professional relationships**, and **exchange knowledge** with this diverse group. Furthermore, being involved in an EU project CoP can improve your **professional visibility** in an **international** context.
